Guidelines to nominate for the Committee of the APDT Australia Inc.

Please read the new APDT Constitution 2019 – in particular, ‘Part 3 Committee’ to better understand the committee composition and eligibility to hold office.

For your nomination to be valid, you must:

1. Be eligible as described in the APDT Constitution 2019
2. Submit an accurately completed Committee Nomination form. Ensure that names, addresses, and membership numbers are accurate and that all people on the form are **current financial members** at the time of signing the form.
3. Return the Committee Nomination form by the closing date. For this election, you must return an accurately completed form by the closing date of:

16 September 2022 at 5 pm

You must scan/photograph and email the form to the Returning Officer by the closing date and time to be valid.
