# Guidelines to nominate for the Committee of the APDT Australia Inc.

Please read the APDT Constitution 2019, particularly 'Part 3 Committee,' to better understand the committee's composition and eligibility to hold office.

For your nomination to be **valid**, you must:

1. Be **eligible** as described in the APDT Constitution 2019
2. **Submit** an accurately completed Committee Nomination Form. When signing the form, ensure that names, addresses, and membership numbers are accurate and that all people on the form are **current financial members**.
3. **Return** the completed Committee Nomination Form by:

**13 September 2024 at 5 pm**
